We are collaborating with the NYMAC state Chapters of the American Academy of Family Physicians and the American College of Physicians to invite a very select number of second-year residents and faculty advisors who are interested in providing care to adult patients with genetic conditions from the NYMAC states and District of Columbia to attend this one-day conference.
