

MYSTERY PATIENT DRILL

The **PCEPN Mystery Patient Drill** is designed to test screening and isolation protocols at primary care facilities. PCEPN will work with site representatives on the execution and evaluation of drill. Participating primary care networks will be provided \$2,000 for the purchase of biological/infectious disease preparedness materials.
