


INSURANCE COVERAGE OF NYS FQHC PATIENTS


## **INCREASING ACCESS**

In the five years since the implementation of the Affordable Care Act, 690,000 additional New Yorkers have gained access to primary care at an FQHC.




# PARTNERING WITH GOVERNMENT TO SERVE THOSE IN NEED
