 - And a person record
- Communications Directory role assignments refer to the person record for contact information.

User Data: Accounts Record



- Created and managed by NYSDOH.
- Contains important information like Ecommerce ID, PIN and primary organization.
- Users maintain their own account record.

- Changes in this record are synchronized with the accounts record.

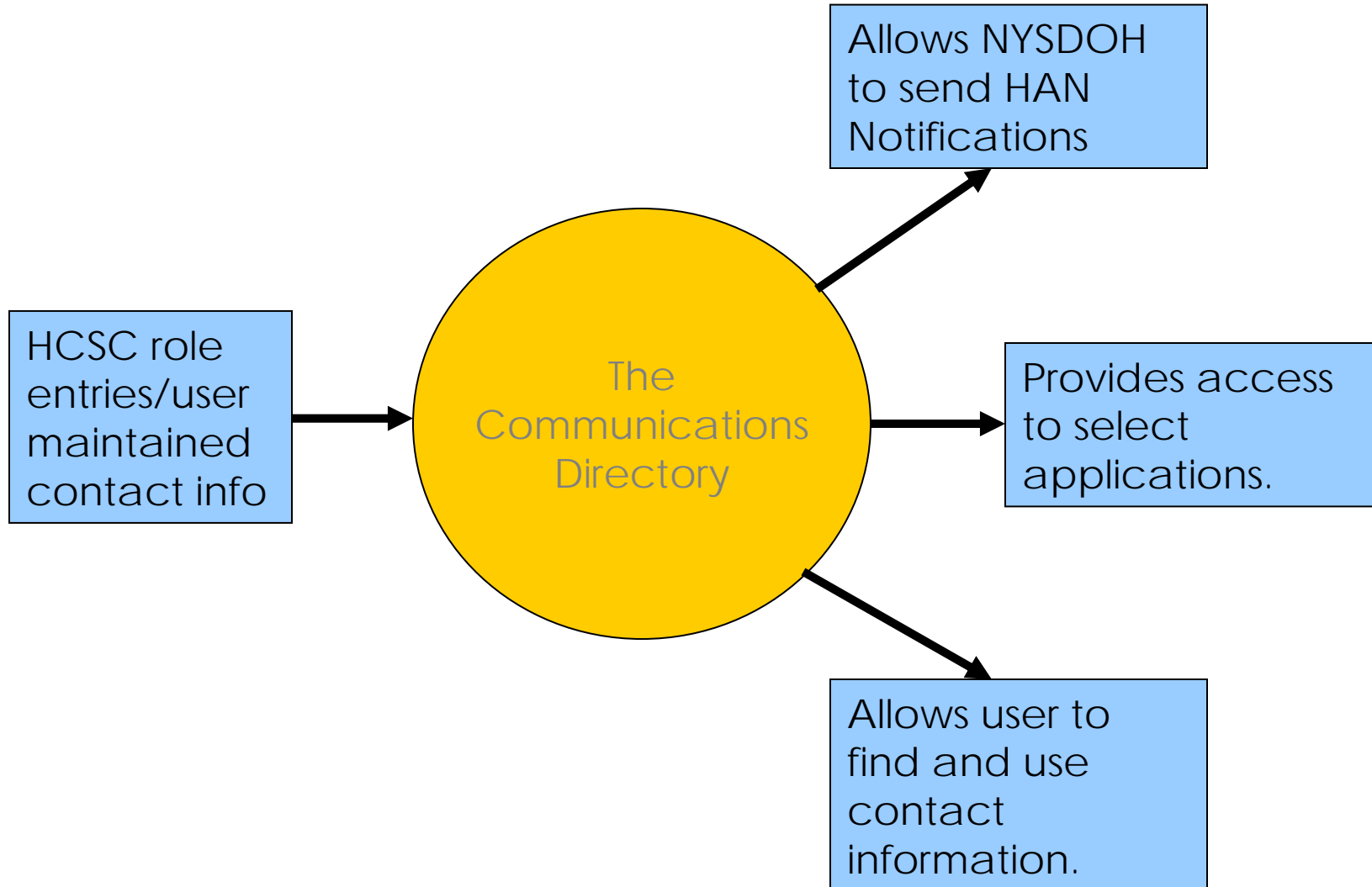




