

Opportunities to learn and improve the UDS Mapper at the NACHC CHI

In a period of landmark health system reform and safety net expansion, it is essential that HRSA, BPHC, and health center organizations have access to tools and data that can assist in evaluating the geographic reach, penetration, and growth of the Section 330-funded Health Center Program and its relationship to other federally-linked health resources. As such, HRSA, John Snow, Inc. and the Robert Graham Center have collaborated to develop a mapping and decision-support tool driven primarily from data within the Uniform Data System (UDS), previously not publicly accessible at the local level. The UDS Mapper is part of the *HealthLandscape* online mapping platform.
