


TYPE OF COMMUNITY





DANY CYCLE III

- 2012-13 State Budget included changes for the PPS and LR programs:
 - Awards made w/o competitive bid
 - Work group established develop a streamlined application
 - DOH provide technical assistance
 - DOH act on a completed application w/in 30 days
- PWPG (workgroup) included CHCANYS, HANYS, MSSNY, GNYHA and other reps.
- November 2012

MEDICAID 1115 WAIVER

- Submitted to CMS on August 6, 2012
- Requested \$10 billion of the \$18.3 billion in federal savings from MRT reforms to implement action plan to transform health care system over 5 years
- Reinvestment in state's health care system to achieve the Triple Aim of better health, better care and lower costs
- \$500 million targeted for Health Workforce Initiatives

ENSURING THE HEALTH WORKFORCE MEETS THE NEEDS IN THE NEW ERA OF HEALTH CARE REFORM

- Funding for training and re-training the state's health care workforce to meet changes in health system workforce needs and to promote patient-centered, team-based, coordinated care.
- Expanding DANY programs, and the newly enacted Primary Care Services Corps that targets non-physician clinicians in medically underserved communities

MEDICAL RESIDENT INCENTIVES

- Pay enhanced salaries or loan repayment to medical residents who agree to work in a medically underserved community upon completion of residency
- Funding would be set-aside for annually for a cohort of approximately 100 - 200 residents (max. of 4 cohorts)
- Amounts substantially increase for those who will commit to practice in rural area

OTHER AREAS

- GME Policy & Reimbursement
- Federal budget reform
- Initiatives to retain more NYS trained residents
- Grant support for Area Health Education Centers (AHEC) & Diversity initiatives
- Discussing initiatives to diversify medical school admission criteria & curricula to reflect societal make-up, including interest in serving underserved communities
