Over the past 3 years:

- **75%** of CHCANYS Community HealthCorps alumni have gone into health care-related career tracks.
- Of these, 43% went on to work in Community Health Centers, other primary care clinics or hospitals in underserved communities.
- Others have pursued graduate school education relevant to the field medical school, nursing school, psychology, education, and social work.
