

Primary Care Information Project (PCIP) Overview

PCIP, a bureau of NYC Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, uses health IT to reduce health disparities among the patients we serve.



PCIP Public Health Improvements


Doctors delivered <u>3 times</u> the number of recommended preventive services

Improved diabetes management for **81,000 patients**

Improved blood pressure for **96,000 patients**

58,000 smokers got access to cessation programs

Unpublished estimates; data from 150 practices on EHR Oct 2009-Oct 2011



Healthix Integration Incentive Program Overview

- Increasing provider participation in RHIOs is priority goal for PCIP.
- RHIOs helps make health data available for use in reducing health disparities among New York City's patient population.
- RHIO connectivity is also important for Meaningful Use Stage 2 and New York programs like Delivery System Reform Incentive Payment (DSRIP) and PCHH care coordination.
- This program is a collaboration between PCIP, CHCANYS, Healthix, eClinicalWorks (eCW), and New York eHealth Collaborative (NYeC).
- As a part of this effort, PCIP is sponsoring the cost of Healthix integration and 1 year of eClinicalWorks eHx subscription fees for FQHCs using eCW.
- We're collaborating with NYeC to ensure financial parity across the PCIP and NYeC RHIO incentive programs.
 - Participating FQHCs may be entitled to a \$7,500 incentive payment from the NYeC.
 - FQHCs must follow the process of the NYeC/NY State Department of Health Data Exchange Incentive Program in order to claim the NYeC incentive.




Covered Services



Program Timeline

After pre-integration activities are completed, the Healthix Integration process usually takes about 6-8 weeks.



FQHC Roles, Responsibilities and Time Commitment

The Healthix and eCW teams will perform the majority of the integration tasks. However, health center collaboration is critical to the success of the project providing EHR access.

Health Center Roles	Responsibilities	Total Time Commitment
FQHC Liaison	 Execute Data Validation test cases Provide feedback on accuracy of data Coordinate activities listed below Meet regularly with eCW and Healthix team 	10 hrs
Technical Analyst	 Provide access to the CHC network via RDP and/or VPN Provide credentials to backend EHR via SQL Provide credentials to front end EHR via user interface (same as CHC staff) 	10 hrs
Provider, MA, Front Office Staff	 Attend Healthix training Review consent process 	4 hrs
