

## ***SBIRT Procedure for Obtaining Data***

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**PURPOSE:** To provide a procedure for obtaining data for reporting on number of patients screened with SBIRT (screening, brief intervention, referral to treatment).

**APPLIES TO:** Behavioral Health and Quality Department staff

**PROCEDURE:** SBIRT is a model of care for enhancing assessment and brief intervention for people with substance use issues in the primary care setting. The process includes universal screening for risky substance use (including alcohol, drugs, and prescription medication misuse).

SBIRT screening is reported annually as part of the UDS (Uniform Data System).

Data is pulled using CPT codes 99408, 99409, H0049, H0050, G0396, and G0397.

In addition to CPT codes, reporting for SBIRT also includes: Patients who receive an Audit and/or DAST, AND then a brief intervention (15 minutes) with BHC.

Data is pulled monthly and reviewed by the Behavioral Health staff.
