This document provides an overview for participants who have pre-registered for a Kosher/boxed lunch *or* are receiving lunch vouchers.

- Participants who pre-registered for a Kosher or boxed lunch received an e-mail notice of confirmation prior to Advocacy Day. Their names are noted on a list handled by CHCANYS staff located in Meeting Room 1. Those receiving a Kosher or boxed lunch will *not* receive a voucher.
- Send only one person from each health center/organization to sign for and pick up lunch vouchers on behalf of the group. One voucher per person.
- Please safeguard your vouchers like cash. They are non-replaceable.
- Remind the cashier that the voucher is tax exempt as noted.
- The value of the voucher is \$8.50. Any excess is the responsibility of the customer and not CHCANYS. No change is given.
- The voucher is authorized by Sodexo caterers and can only be used at the cafeterias listed. Please note hours of operation and locations and allow enough time to purchase lunch before/between your legislative appointments.
- The cafeterias are used by other groups and personnel. Limited seating is available in Meeting Room 1. Meeting Room 5 will also be available, *except from 12:30 to 2:00 p.m.*
- Return unused vouchers to CHCANYS staff in Meeting Room 1; vouchers can not be redeemed for cash.

- #17 Hutch House Bakery (7:00 a.m. 4 p.m.) limited menu (not a deli selection); mostly baked goods, fruit, Starbucks
