Annual Summary of Vital Statistics for 2005 Released

The life expectancy of New Yorkers increased nearly 5 months in one year, the Health Department announced today as it released its latest Annual Summary of Vital Statistics. Life expectancy reached 78.6 years for a New Yorker born in 2004. This is 9.6 months more than the City's life expectancy in 2001 and 8.4 months more than the 2004 national life expectancy (77.9).

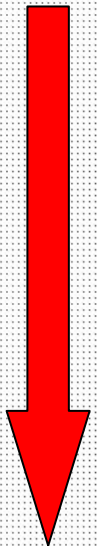

HPN Background - Since 1998, the New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH) internet based community infrastructure has provided highly secure and efficient exchange of reporting, surveillance, statistical, and general information with its public health and health provider partners. The Health Provider Network (HPN) is a HIPAA compliant system that currently supports reporting and information interchange pertaining to vital records and registries, disease surveillance and response, and health facilities management. The HPN is also used by the NYSDOH as its principal means for disseminating and gathering important and sensitive information and data regarding bioterrorism preparedness, surveillance and response.

Use of the HPN has benefited healthcare providers in that it:

- a. provides simple and immediate access to important information products that may be updated on a continuous basis;
- b. employs a number of network level safeguards to provide secure electronic transit of sensitive and confidential data;
- c. simplifies and expedites reporting processes;
- d. facilitates immediate access to a provider's own data for analysis and compiling summary statistics;
- e. protects data stored on central servers from the view of all but those individuals specifically authorized.

HPN user organizations include New York State, New York City, and county health departments; hospitals; and various emergency service organizations.



Communications Assessment Provides Guidance for Urban Area First Responders

January 3, 2007– The Department released scorecard assessments of interoperable communications capabilities in 75 urban and metropolitan areas nationwide. Interoperable communications involve policies, technology and training that enable law enforcement, fire and emergency medical services from multiple jurisdictions in a common community to effectively communicate within one hour of an incident.

"The 9/11 Commission identified interoperable communications as a major challenge and many communities listened by taking the sometimes difficult steps necessary to close communication gaps among first responders," said Secretary Michael Chertoff. "Their experience proves that basic interoperability at the command level is achievable. We're committed to making this a priority in every major urban area, and we'll continue to push for closing these gaps by the end of 2008." [Read more.](#)

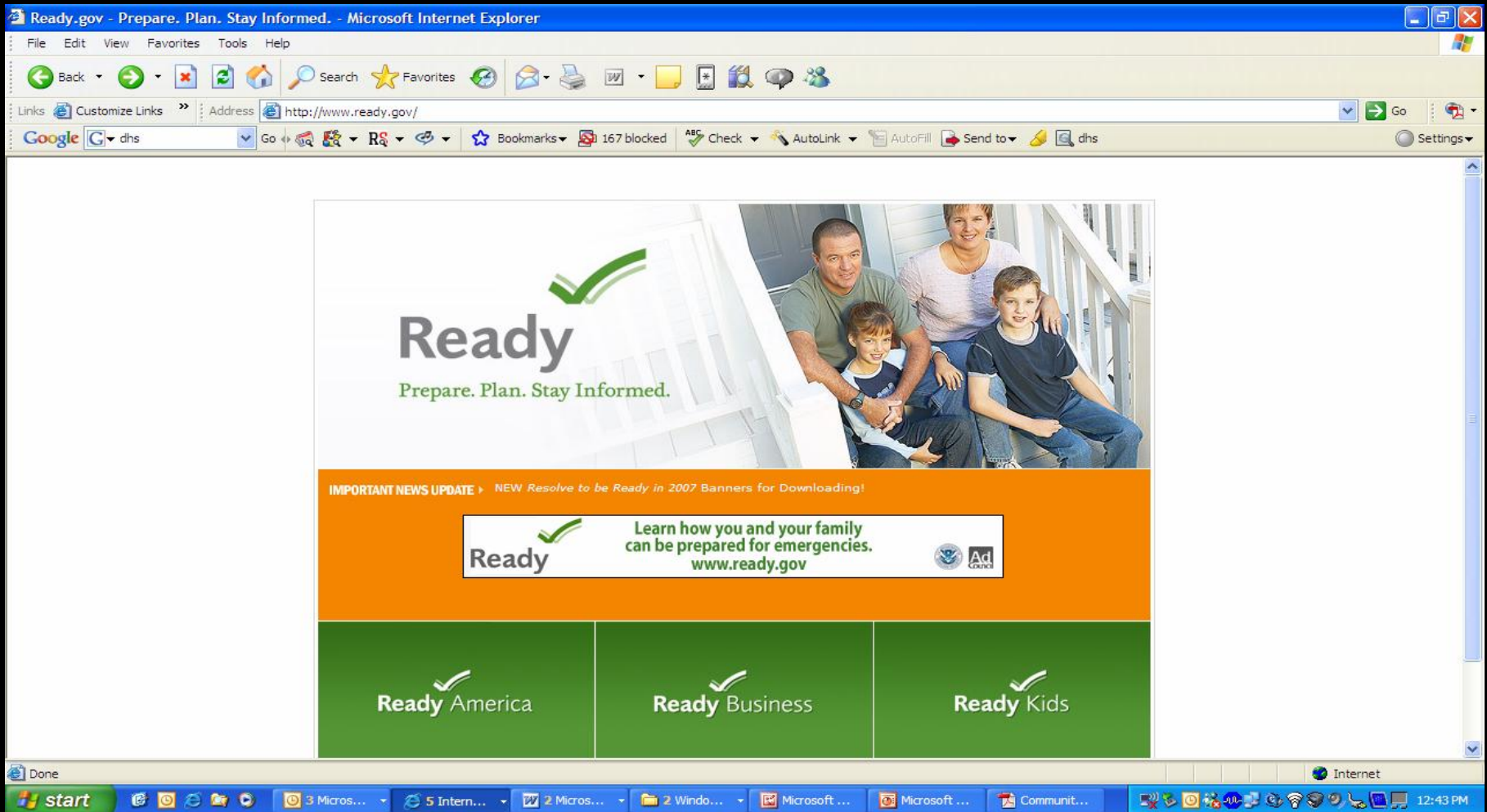

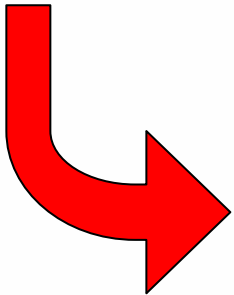


